	Pregnant or Parenting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This applies to an applicant who is a Mother or Father • Birth certificate of child with applicant's name as parent • Doctor's note confirming pregnancy
	Youth Requiring Additional Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Notice of Action • Section 8 Housing documents • Letter from Case Worker verifying eligibility
	Foster or Emancipated / Aftercare Youth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Need placement documents • Documentation from ILP verifying Foster or Aftercare affiliation
	Homeless or Runaway	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Statement from Shelter • Self Attestation from Participant
	Basic Skills Deficient	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Below 9th grade in Reading or Math determined by test performed by Career Institute staff
